

Atheist Logic:

Has a creator

And what do
you believe ?

We know that our live—no matter how wonderful it may be—is characterised by a lot of suffering. There may be problems in our relationships or at work, as well as financial worries. The loss of health and ultimately death is something that awaits everyone some day. The resulting separation from our loved ones is also a source of great concern to many of us. For centuries, people have tried to effectively ease or prevent these sufferings—but without success. State-of-the-art technology or artificial intelligence will never be able to change this.

On top of that, many people also fear what will happen after death. Is there a God? Will there be judgement or punishment in hell?

Yet people categorically reject or simply ignore both the cause and the solution to all these sufferings. This is why they cannot overcome the worries about death and the 'afterlife'. By observing the highly complex creation, with all its design, beauty, fine-tuning and programmed information, people know that it cannot have come into being by chance. Therefore, there must be a God and Creator of all these things.

But instead of giving honour, thanks, obedience and worship to the one true God, people—contrary to all scientific evidence—simply explain the existence of the world as a product of chance emerging from 'nothing'. But nothing comes from nothing, life always comes from life. Design, programmed information and irreducible complexity must have been created by an almighty Creator.

Others have realised this and turn to a form of spirituality and call upon 'higher beings' found in many religions. Yet this form of religiosity offers no solution to sufferings and worries, because these 'higher beings' are man-made and therefore lifeless idols. Ultimately, people obey, honour and worship anti-divine powers instead of the one true, living God.

Also, many so-called 'Christian' groups or 'churches', bear the name 'Christian' and, in theory, they speak of the Bible as the Word of God. However, due to practical rejection of God's Word in doctrine and practice, they in reality represent a 'false Christianity', which, in the end, will neither bring salvation nor redemption, just like atheistic godlessness or false religion.

All sufferings have a spiritual cause—namely, that people turn away from their God and Creator through unbelief, disobedience ('sin') and ingratitude. The rightful consequence of this is death and judgement.

The solution to all sufferings, worries and fears can only be found in turning to the one true God and Creator. He has revealed Himself to us humans—in addition to His general revelation through creation—solely in the Bible, the Word of God. As creation certainly points to a Creator, the Bible certainly proves to be the one true and trustworthy Word of God: The Bible is unique concerning its historical reliability, fulfilled prophecy, spiritual authority, unity, and answers to the important questions about God, humanity and creation.

The very fact that there is an opportunity for redemption, repentance, forgiveness and restoration for people is based solely on God: He brings salvation through His Son, Jesus the Christ. As a substitute, Jesus Christ took upon Himself the guilt and punishment of sin through His sacrificial death on the cross and his bodily resurrection on the third day.

Anyone who turns to this one true God and Creator in the name of Jesus Christ and in consistent obedience of faith, will, through what Jesus did on the cross, have a share in the resurrection from the dead and in an eternal new world where suffering, sorrow and death will no longer exist. In this new world, we will also be reunited with our loved ones for eternity, if they too have turned to Jesus Christ in repentance and obedience of faith during their lifetime.
